



You will choose a song that reflects 1 or more topics that have been covered in the current unit. This song must have clean or censored lyrics. Songs may come from any era so long as you can find relevance to the topic/event.

- Once you have chosen a song, identify the sections in the lyrics that you believe best represent the topics/events that you are exploring. The lyrics must also be included. “I like this song” will not make the grade.
- Find primary documents (Photos, paintings, documents, etc.) that you feel express the sentiments and messages in the song best. These do not have to be period specific as long as there is a connection that you can make that is relevant and justified.
- Choose the format in which you will present this material. You have two choices:
  - Power point or Multi-Media presentation
    - including song itself
    - primary documents, pictures
    - Introduction given to the class (may be written, embedded in the presentation, or attached electronically)
    - embedded lyrics to highlight phrases you believe are important
    - Minimum of 10 sides required for a PASSING GRADE. Better grades require more.
    - Printed copy of lyrics must be included (paper submission or separate electronic file) when submitting your project
    - Works cited page must be included referencing all documents used and referenced for project (paper submission or separate electronic file)
  - Essay
    - Proper essay format is required
    - Primary documents must be used and included in your works cited
    - 2-5 pages (not including your works cited page)
    - Must make clear connections to the lyrics and material covered in class.
    - Printed copy of lyrics must be included when submitting your paper
- Citation is expected and required
- Help will always be given to those who ask...SO ASK.
- If thought is not included in the work received, it will show and be reflected in your grade.
- The rubric for this project is attached. (also available online)

Once all projects for all units are completed, a compilation album will be created using the song that best represent the units and events we have worked on in class. These albums will be available to the students who actively stay in Mr. Carleno’s good graces.
